- Create and deliver engaging, hands-on lesson plans covering digital photography (camera operations, lighting, composition), full-cycle video production (pre-production planning, filming, audio, lighting, editing), and graphic design.
- Collaborate with administration to create high-quality, student-produced visual content for school promotions, social media, and marketing.
